

ICD-10 Codes Associated with Breast Implant Illness

Below is a list of *some of the* ICD 10 codes that have been associated with Breast Implant Illness. This is just a start. You may have other symptoms that result in your doctor treating you like you're a bit nuts.

The goal is to list *anything that you have noticed that has changed in your health since you got your implants*. The jury is still out on all of them. Use as much as you can. Some ICD codes are just symptoms. And, we all know that our doctors don't take the time to listen to all of our complaints these days. That's especially true if you have several problems. Don't fall victim to this.

Each diagnosis code/symptom should be explained: quality, intensity, and length of time. Here are some examples:

- **M12.88:** Other Specific Arthropathies
- **M13.80:** Other specified arthritis, unspecified site
- **M13.81:** Other specified arthritis, shoulder (e.g., M13.811 for right shoulder)
- **M13.82:** Other specified arthritis, elbow
- **M13.83:** Other specified arthritis, wrist
- **M13.84:** Other specified arthritis, hand/fingers
- **M13.85:** Other specified arthritis, hip
- **M13.86:** Other specified arthritis, knee
- **M13.87:** Other specified arthritis, ankle and foot
- **M13.88:** Other specified arthritis, vertebrae, spine
- **M13.89:** Other specified arthritis, multiple sites
- **M13.8** or **M13.8X:** Other Specified arthritis
- **M25.5:** Pain in joint
- **M25.51:** Pain in shoulder
- **M54.2:** Generalized neck pain. *Do not let your doctor just say it's arthritis. A lot of people have joint calcification and no pain. The level of inflammation is the key, which can be set off by the inflammatory response to Implants.*
- **M81.0:** Osteoporosis: *This can be age related. But if you are below 50 and you have it, many lab tests should be run to find the cause. Tests may reveal that BII is the cause of your inflammation.*
- **N61:** Inflammatory disorders of breast (if inflammation present)

- **N64.4:** Mastodynia, or breast pain
- **N64.89** – Other specified disorders of breast
- **N64.9:** Disorder of breast, unspecified (warm to the touch)
- **R06.02:** Shortness of breath
- **R11.2:** Unexplained Nausea and vomiting
- **R19.7:** Unexplained Diarrhea.
- **R41.9:** Unspecified symptoms and signs involving cognitive functions and awareness (“brain fog”)
- **R42:** unexplained dizziness (or giddyness)
- **R51.9:** Unspecified Headache
- **R59.0:** Enlarged lymph nodes associated with breasts
- **R59.9:** Enlarged lymph nodes, unspecified.
- **R60.9** – Edema, unspecified (if generalized swelling)
- **R76.9:** Unexplained lab findings in the serum that are indicative of an autoimmune process (such as a positive ANA test) but without a confirmed diagnosis. Make sure you have these lab tests to prove.
- **R89.1:** Abnormal level of hormones in specimens from other organs, systems, and tissues.
- **T85.43XA:** Leakage of breast prosthesis and implant
